

Art Est. Emerging Curator's Program

This program is designed to support emerging curators develop their skills by curating an exhibition in the Art Est. Gallery in Leichhardt.

What is provided?

Art Est. will allocate the Gallery space for an exhibition of 2 weeks duration.

The Gallery provides 50m² of exhibition space. The walls are Gyprock painted white with 40m of running wall length with a height of 2m, and a brick wall also painted white with a length of 6m and a height of 3m. Plinths of various sizes are available, there is also scope to make use of the high ceilings.

The exhibition can use the whole Gallery space or use a feature project wall.

Exhibitions of 2D, 3D and new media are encouraged. However, be aware that the Gallery is also part of an Art School that caters for children and the content will need to be 'family friendly'. Precarious or

What is the cost?

Art Est. will waive the Gallery hire fee and provide use of the Gallery, gallery hanging system and assistance with hanging, management of art sales use of Art Est. Eftpos facilities, assistance designing e invites and media release, e-invitation to the Art Est. and Curator's mailing list, and invigilation during normal business hours.

Art Est. will charge 30% commission on the sale of any artworks, inclusive of GST.

Costs for event catering and printed invitations will be the responsibility of the curator. We encourage you to seek sponsorship for these.

Who can apply?

The purpose of the program is to support emerging curators to develop their practice. Arts Administration students or recent visual art graduates are encouraged to apply,

How to Apply

Applications for this program are accepted throughout the year. Exhibition dates are subject to availability our regular exhibition program. Applications must include the following

- an explanation in 500 words (1 x A4 page) of the exhibition project you will undertake and who will be involved. Include images.
- a copy of your CV including any previous curatorial work. Please include the CV of artists involved in the project.
- the names and contact details of 2 referees who are familiar with your practice (eg former lecturers)
